

Cathars and Quakers a pilgrimage tour in SW France september 16 - 23 2015

700 years after their ruthless eradication by the fire, sword and inquisition, the Cathar 'church' is now the subject of much study and admiration, and many of its characteristics echo harmoniously with Quaker faith and practice.

You don't have to be a reincarnated Cathar or a practicing Quaker to share this exploration into holding one's truth in contrary times.

A 7 day tour in 'Cathar Country' – the Ariège, Aude and Hérault, a pilgrimage, weaving together visits to countryside and Chateaux, with group meetings, meditations and presentations, invoking and exploring the Cathar faith and our own.

With a special trip to the earliest "Quaker" Meeting House in France at Congenies.

The cost is 760 euros per person in shared rooms, including transports from Carcassonne, all accommodation, breakfasts and evening meals (not lunches), and most admissions to sites. Single room supplement 140 euros. Limited to 20 pilgrims - book early!
